

From the May 16th Bracket Event Willowbank Raceway will introduce a new Group 4 Bracket for motorcycle competitors.

PS/B - Pro Street / Bike

This Group 4 Bracket will be run on a Fixed Index of 9.00 seconds on a Full Tree for the first Event. Next season (2009/2010) will change to a Pro Tree. The Bracket will run as Chicago Shootout when there are 16 bikes or less. More than 16 bikes bracket will be run as Eliminations.

The rules for the bracket are as follows

- No wheelie bars
- No nitro methane fuel
- No mechanical or electronic engine delay devices permitted

All bikes and riders must comply with full ANDRA rules and track regulations on licencing and technical inspections.

Chicago Shootout Rules

1. In the event of an uneven field the three top qualifiers over the index will be awarded the bye runs.
2. In the event of a scheduled Bye run or a solo run (broken opponent) to be allocated win points the bike needs to be judged to have completed a pass representative of the bikes previous performance.
3. In the event of both riders going under the index in a single race, the rider closest to 9.00 in that race will be awarded the win for that round.
4. If more than two riders are on maximum round wins after three rounds of racing the two riders closest to 9.00 over the index in the LAST round of racing will contest the final.
5. If a competitor has to withdraw from racing during race rounds they must immediately notify the bracket official. If you have withdrawn you CANNOT run any further rounds of racing.

Below is the seeding to be used in the event of an uneven field and an even field if say 9 or 10 bikes are entered for the class to show how it will rotate. It just continues in the same format for however many entries there are.
