



Summernats City Cruise

Conditions & Guidelines

- Production vehicles only. (No agricultural vehicles, lawn mowers, off-road buggies or tube chassis race vehicles).
- Vehicles to operate on pump fuel only. No Aviation fuel or nitrous oxide.
- Wheels and Tyres not to protrude beyond body of vehicle. Wheels must be covered by guards. Tyres must maintain legal tread and tread depth. No slicks.
- Vehicles to maintain a minimum ground clearance of 80mm. There is to be no operation of variable suspension systems (e.g. air/hydraulic suspension systems) during the Summernats City Cruise.
- Vehicle must be fitted with an exhaust system and muffler. Vehicles to operate below 100dB (< 100dB(A) measured as per the National Stationary Noise Test.) All exhaust pipes to be shielded.
- Vehicles must have a bonnet. All moving engine components, like drive belts, are to be shielded.
- Any protrusions above the bonnet (e.g. air intake systems) that inhibit the driver's field of view must operate with a licenced driver in the passenger front seat to serve as a spotter. Front seat passengers fulfilling the spotter function must not use cameras or other electronic devices.
- Vehicles to operate with seat belts as per the Australian Road Rules (ARRs).
- No standing positions.
- Vehicles to operate brakes on all wheels.
- Vehicles must face forward.
- Unregistered and/or modified vehicles that are accepted to take part in the Summernats City Cruise must apply for a special temporary permit to be able to participate. Applications will be forwarded to those chosen prior to the event. This is not the same as a Summernats permit.
